Rainbow Beach State School will receive

\$46,303*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure 80% of Prep – Year 3 students are achieving at or above year level benchmark in Reading by the end of 2019.
- Ensure 75% of students achieve a 'C' standard or better in English and Maths in Semester 2 reporting across the school.
- Ensure 100% of Years 3 and 5 students achieve above the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in all strands.
- Maintain Mean Scale Score in Writing for Year 3 and Year 5 to similar or above like schools in 2019.
- Maintain 50% of students achieving results in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) from Year 3 to Year 5 in Numeracy and Writing.

Our initiatives include

- Purchasing teaching staff to implement the Australian Curriculum in Year 1, to ensure year level outcomes are achieved Prep-Yr 3.
- The continued development of a whole school approach to the teaching of writing through the use of Pearson's Gradual Release of Responsibility Model as a pedagogical framework, and an explicit and purposeful daily writing routine within the C2C.
- Purchasing additional release time for all teaching staff to effectively plan for daily explicit writing routines by using the achievement standards for writing within the English Anchor Charts.
- Developing staff capacity to plan and implement the Australian Mathematics Curriculum by utilising the Gympie Alliance Mathematics planning documents.
- Purchasing teacher aide staff to implement effective intervention and reading programs.
