#### Term Two-

#### NAPLAN Online -

Commencing Tuesday next week, we will have students in Year 3 and Year 5 participating in NAPLAN testing. The information on student learning we gather through the NAPLAN testing process informs the strategic direction of our school. While it is a, "one-off" test and does not give a whole picture on student achievement, NAPLAN still gives us some indication of the effectiveness of our teaching programs. It is vitally important that year 3 & 5 students be at school by 8.15am on these days so they can organise and settle themselves prior to the testing. If your child is unable to attend on these days please let us know as soon as possible.

In 2022, students in years 3 and 5 will sit the NAPLAN online tests. In light of this, we have been preparing and training in order to be ready since mid-2020 with several staff attending training workshops, students and staff participating in practice sessions and testing online functionality and capacity. Students in year 3 this year will be completing their writing test using the traditional paper-based tests.


