

Purchasing additional Speech Language Pathologist time Focus on Prep – year 2 Speech intervention for severe speech delay and support of Literacy and Language acquisition. Student assessments as prioritised and required. Staff support of teachers and Aides to incorporate intervention in the classroom in relation to differentiation and adjustments.	Additional Speech Language Pathologist purchased to increase service to 4 days / term - \$9 000	\$9,000
Providing release time for teachers to engage in Moderation processes, planning and effective teaching.	TRS for teacher release to engage with Moderation, planning and Professional Development- \$8 000	\$8,000
